
Welcome Packets for Our Guests

MAY is Boater Education & Safety Month. During the month of May, we will be providing the Washington State Boater's Education Card Study Course and Exam to each guest boat. This is a quick and easy way to obtain your mandatory boating card! Use this along with your free CD Boater's Reference Guide which includes information and interactive self exams on Rules of the Road, Northwest Weather Observation, Basic, Coastal, and Electronic Navigation, Marlinespike Seamanship & Boat Handling, Firefighting & Emergency response. Also included are printable PDF files for Washington State & USCG Boating Accident Reporting Forms and much more!

May 22nd: The USCG Auxiliary will provide free safety inspections and award new decals & certificates to passing vessels. Please contact the harbormaster prior to May 22 to schedule a time for the inspection.

The Nexus Card

The NEXUS Program allows prescreened, low risk travelers an expedited process upon entry to the U.S. and Canada. Approved applicants are issued an identification card valid for five years. Boaters may use the **Nexus** (**Highway Card**) for travel between U.S. and Canada in the Puget Sound Region. The Nexus Marine card is valid on for the Great Lakes!
