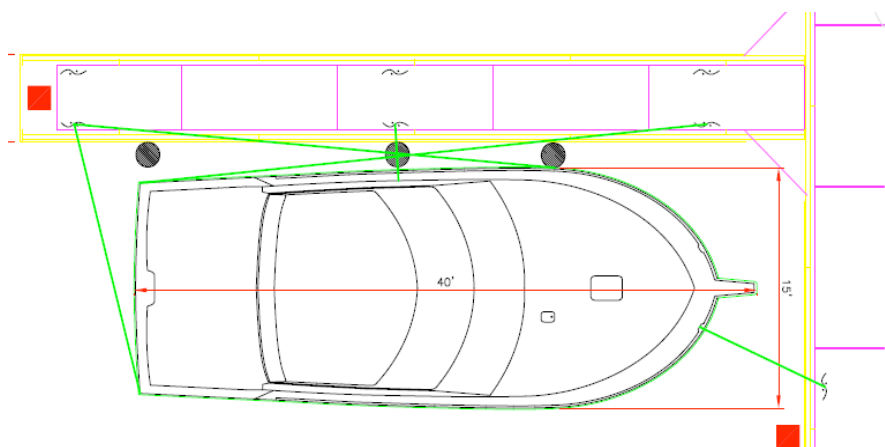

Around the Cleat...Line Handling Tips

Do you find that the stern drifts away from the dock when boarding or getting off your vessel? This commonly occurs when the stern line cleat is behind the transom? Here is a simple fix: use an off-shore Stern line, this will keep the stern tight to the dock. (an offshore bow line can also be effective).
