

2012 DockStock Festival ART Contest

Winning design will be used for the *Port of South Whidbey's* 4th annual DockStock Festival Posters, Commemorative T-Shirts and promotional advertising. The artist will receive \$100 prize money with a featured "Artist Bio", and the artist's design will be designated as the "*official artwork*" for DockStock 2012.- Music on the Pier.

How to Enter:

Completed artwork must be postmarked or delivered by April 16th to the Harbormaster at the Port of South Whidbey. Each entry must include:

- A completed entry form attached to the artwork
- Artwork

Procedures & Rules:

The intent of the contest is to find original artwork which reflects the bright colors and attitude of summer fun, music and festive atmosphere at the Port's annual party for boaters, the DockStock Music Festival. Entries will be judged on the quality and suitability of the art, which is to be featured on posters, t-shirts and advertising for the 2012 event.

- The *DockStock Art Contest* is open to anyone of any age. Only one entry per person will be accepted.
- The artwork should reflect the DockStock Music Festival at the Harbor and should be suitable for the front of a light colored T-shirt (Note: A full-color spectrum is allowed, but the digital printing process on the shirt will not print white)
- All artwork must be the contestant's original, hand-done creation not already published or in use.
- Do not sign the artwork. The winner will be asked to sign artwork after the design has been selected.
- All artwork must be 8.5" x 11" without a mat, frame, or border.
- Designs with intricate detailing that will be difficult to print on a t-shirt as well as clip art and other copyrighted art will be immediately rejected.
- A Judging Committee from the Port will select the winning Artwork, all decisions final.
- Notification of the winner will be made by April 30th, 2012
- If contestants would like artwork returned, it will be available at the Port office for pickup from May 1 until May 31. If you wish it to be returned by mail, please include return mailing materials, mailing address, and postage. If those are items are not included in the request for return mail, it will NOT be mailed back to you.
- As a condition of accepting the prize, the winner of the contest will be required to assign to the Port of South Whidbey all rights for the artwork, with no additional consideration or approval required for art use for DockStock promotion and commemorative items. Further, the Port of South Whidbey may use name and likeness of Winner for advertising, fundraising, promotional, and/or publicity purposes associated with DockStock Festival without further compensation. (If these conditions are not acceptable, please don't submit.) Winner will be responsible for all applicable taxes and any and all expenses associated with claiming the Prize.
