In August, **DockStock - Music on the Pier** returned for the second year. Boaters were entertained with Jazz, Country, Pop and Rock 'n Roll provided by six local groups from Western Washington. This year we added a Crab Cook-off competition, which provided some delightful benefits for the panel of judges!

In September, the Mukilteo Yacht Club brought not only their members for an annual round-the-buoy race and cruise-in, but also entered the Langley Soup Box Derby and finished second in this annual downhill race, sponsored by Langley Community Club and Langley Men's Club (proceeds go to local charities).

And we are especially proud that in June, the *South Whidbey Harbor at Langley* was certified as a Clean Marina by the State of Washington. We are continuing to address our environmental stewardship goals this year with the renovation of the Pump Out Barge, including the first implementation of environmentally-friendly photoactive bottom coating (metal- and biocide-free) for a barge in this state.

The South Whidbey Harbor at Langley is becoming a popular destination for boating clubs from around Puget Sound. Since we started accepting group reservations up to one year in advance, our staff has assisted over 14 organizations with event planning including ground transportation, local event and dining reservations, and special group activities such as horseback riding, theater tickets and glass blowing.
