
The marina offers free WIFI – Ask for your Login information when registering for moorage.

Around the Cleat...



Tides & Currents – Many boaters heading toward Deception Pass ask, "What is the best <u>tide</u> to transit the pass?"

My reply is always "Within 30 minutes of <u>Slack Water</u> - forget about tide tables and look at your **Current Tables.** Slack water is not the same as High or Low Tide.

The example at the right shows slack water at 9:32 am, but low tide is not until 11:39 am, at which time the current has increased to about 6 kts!

Tides measure vertical movement (Depth) – Current measure horizontal movement (Speed).

What is going on...

Breaking News: South Whidbey Harbor @ Langley has been certified a Washington State Clean Marina.

Clean Marina Washington was created in 2005 as an expansion of the EnviroStars program. Clean Marina Washington is certification program in which marinas assess their operations and implement improvements to better protect the environment. When they reach the qualification standards of Clean Marina Washington the facility and their documentation must pass inspection after which they may receive certification as a Washington State Clean Marina.

The Port of South Whidbey and the harbor staff are proud to have achieved this goal, and will strive maintain the goals as good environmental steward.
