# Soup Box Derby

The Soup Box Derby is an “almost-anything-goes” event that dates back (with a couple of interruptions) to 1972.

Racer design is limited only by the imagination, but each must have brakes and weigh no more than 600 pounds; 300 pounds for those with drivers age 12 and younger.

The race begins at the top of First Street hill near Park Avenue, and runs down the steep incline for a long block or so.
