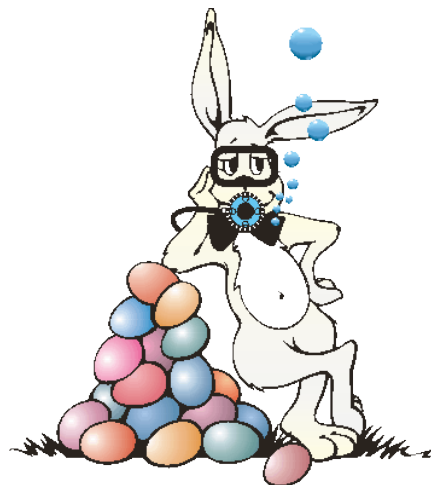

Welcome the Whales, April 21st

This festival, co-sponsored by Orca Network and the Langley Chamber, begins with hands-on educational displays and costume making at the Methodist Church Fellowship Hall at 11 a.m. The parade begins at 1:30 p.m., marching down the hill and ending at Langley Waterfront Park for music and celebration, and perhaps spotting gray whales frolicking and feeding nearby.

The parade of species is led by the 20-foot long “Gary the Gray Whale,” followed by an array of imaginative critters created by local children and adults. Parade participants can design their critter costumes at home, or come early on Saturday and make a costume at the church
