Friendliest Catch Crab Cook-off Competition At the Harbor at Langley August 23rd

Rules and Regulations

Contestants may enter their dishes made with Puget Sound-caught Dungeness or Red Rock Crab which is caught under a recreational license.

One dish per category may be entered. The registration fee is \$10.00 per dish and the categories are:

- Soup
- Crab Cakes
- Dip or Spread
- Specialty Dish

Contestants will be required to provide their own cooking and presentation utensils and presentation plating. Sample and judging utensils, plates and sample cups will be provided by the Harbormaster.

A *complete* list of ingredients must accompany each dish to the judging table.

All dishes must be registered by 1:00 p.m. Judging will start at 2:00 p.m.

Dishes will be judged on:

- Originality
- Presentation
- Taste

There will be two rounds of Judging,

1. A panel of guest judges for Top Choice in each category.
2. The general public will nominate the *People's Choice Award* for favorite overall dish.

Awards will be presented at 4:15 p.m. on the main stage.

Each *Top Choice* winner will receive a prize.

People's Choice winner will receive \$100.00 cash.
